This handbook has developed over the years, beginning with a guide packet for avocational Kansas archeologists compiled by Dianna Rogers and published in 1976-1977 in five separate issues of the *Kansas Anthropological Association Newsletter*. The guide packet was updated and revised in 1980 and published in a single issue (Volume 1, Numbers 5 through 9) in the *Journal of the Kansas Anthropological Association*. The next update was published in 1987 as Volume 7, Numbers 1 through 9 of the *Journal of the KAA*.
